

How to get to Ghent

By Air

Ghent is close to three international airports. From each airport there are bus and train services to Ghent. Most regular airline services are offered via Brussels International Airport.

- Brussels International Airport (Zaventem)
- Antwerp International Airport (e.g. from London City)
- Charleroi Brussels South International Airport

By Train

Most of you coming by air will arrive at Brussels Airport. During the day, at ten to each hour, there is a direct train to "Gent Sint Pieters" (direction "Gent - De Panne"). You can check train schedules at <http://www.b-rail.be/main/E/> - Click on National and use "Brussels Airport" as departing station, and "Gent Sint Pieters" as the destination.

When arriving at Brussels Airport, just go to the lowest level (-1) since the railway station is below street level. You can buy your ticket to Ghent ("Gent") at the desk.

By Car

Choose exit "Gent/Antwerpen" on the E40 (Oostende - Brussel). Follow direction: "Gent-Centrum".

Public Transport in Ghent

Tram/streetcar

From Gent Sint Pieters train station choose line nr. 4 (**lines 21 or 22 are interrupted during February and will not take you to the conference location**). Stop closest to Dunant: Martelaarslaan (Supermarket Delhaize), name of the stop: "Bernard Spaelaan". Then walk for 5 minutes.

- Line 4 stops right in front of the train station and goes in one direction only.
- Line 21/22 stops in the street right to the train station, be sure to take direction "Melle Leeuw" or "Gentbrugge D.C."

There is a tram every approx. every 5 minutes.

Bus

From Gent Sint Pieters train station take bus 9 to "beneluxplein". When you get out, you are exactly at the main entrance of dunant 2.

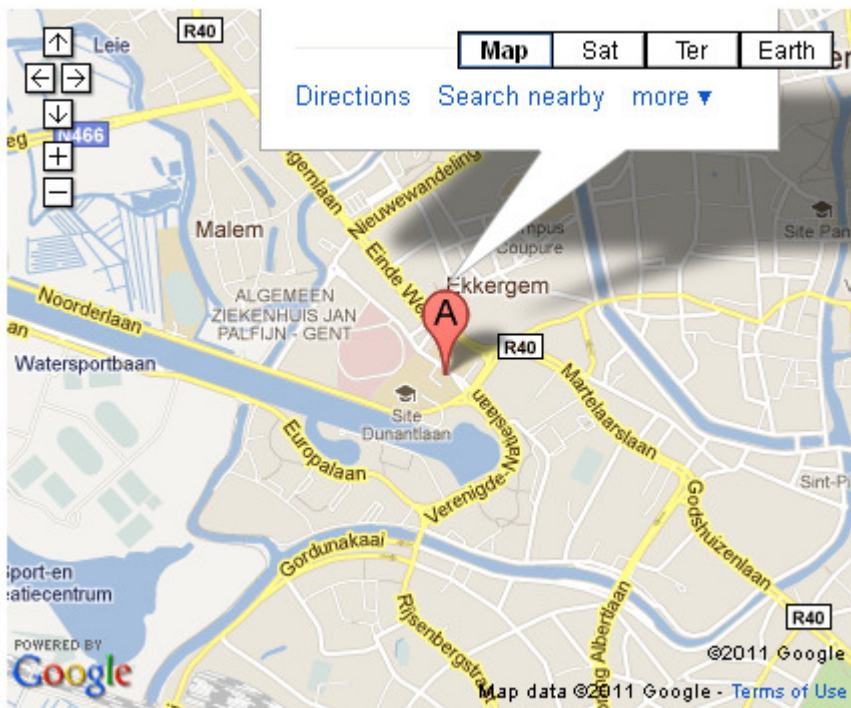
From Gent Sint Pieters train station you can also take bus 14/15 or 65/67/69 to stop "einde were". The red building you see when you get out at "einde were" is Dunant 2, the main entrance is on the other side.

Tickets

For both tram and bus, make sure to **buy your tickets in the train station or outside at the automats (requires coins).** On the bus or tram, it will cost you about 50% extra.
